Inglebrae is a grand old Queenslander (circa 1910), lovingly decorated by hosts Christina and John McDonald. The detail in decoration is wonderful, from fine linens and lace trimmings to antiques and plush furnishings.

Our pick of the three bedrooms available is the suite with its own private sitting room, while the lounge at Inglebrae is delightful, with comfortable furnishings. But our favourite spot to relax or enjoy the cooked breakfast is on the gorgeous white balcony with its inviting wicker furniture and



serene garden views.

Bundaberg is a springboard to the southernmost point of the Great Barrier Reef, with Lady Elliott and Musgrave Islands (the snorkelling is brilliant) close to the shore.

Other attractions include the Turtle refuge, botanical gardens and, of course, the famous rum distillery. Another “must do” is the Bundaberg regional theatre. Christina can organise tickets to their acclaimed shows throughout the year and, combined with dinner at a nearby restaurant, you have the perfect evening.
